Guidelines for Research Paper Submission

1. Formatting:

English papers: MS Word format, Times New Roman, 12-point font, Heading-16, Subheadings-14, 1.5 line spacing, 1-inch margin on all sides.

Hindi & Marathi papers: MS Word format, Unicode font- Mangal, 14-point font, Heading-18, Subheadings-6, 1.5 line spacing, 1-inch margin on all sides.

2. Abstract: Include an abstract of 200 words along with 5-6 relevant keywords.

3. Word Limit: Full paper should be of 2000-3000 words, including references.

4. Citation Style: All references must be cited consistently using APA (Commerce, Science, Social Science) and MLA9 style for Humanities. Include in-text citations and a reference/bibliography section.

5. Plagiarism Policy: All submissions will be checked for plagiarism. The similarity index should not exceed 10%.

6. Authorship: Maximum two authors per paper. All co-authors must register separately.

7. Submission: Please send papers to **researchhubjournal@gmail.com**

8. Review Process: All papers will undergo a peer-review process. Changes, if any, will be conveyed to the authors within 15 days from the date of submission.

Please Note: Use of generative AI will lead to rejection of the paper.

9. Publication: Selected papers will be published in-
a) SCOPUS Indexed Journal with extra publication fees depending upon Journal policy on case to case basis.
